Notes to Church Stewards and Treasurers

(S) denotes Supernumerary Minister, to whom a preaching fee of £21 is payable at the time of the appointment. Travel expenses for Supernumerary Ministers are rated at 25p per mile (or the actual cost of public transport) and should be given with the preaching fee. These fees and expenses may be reclaimed from David Wren, the Circuit Financial Steward.

Expenses should also be offered to other visiting preachers. In the case of Local Preachers from the Sheffield South Circuit, the Circuit Meeting has agreed that they be offered £3 for each appointment to cover travel costs and help with purchasing books.
